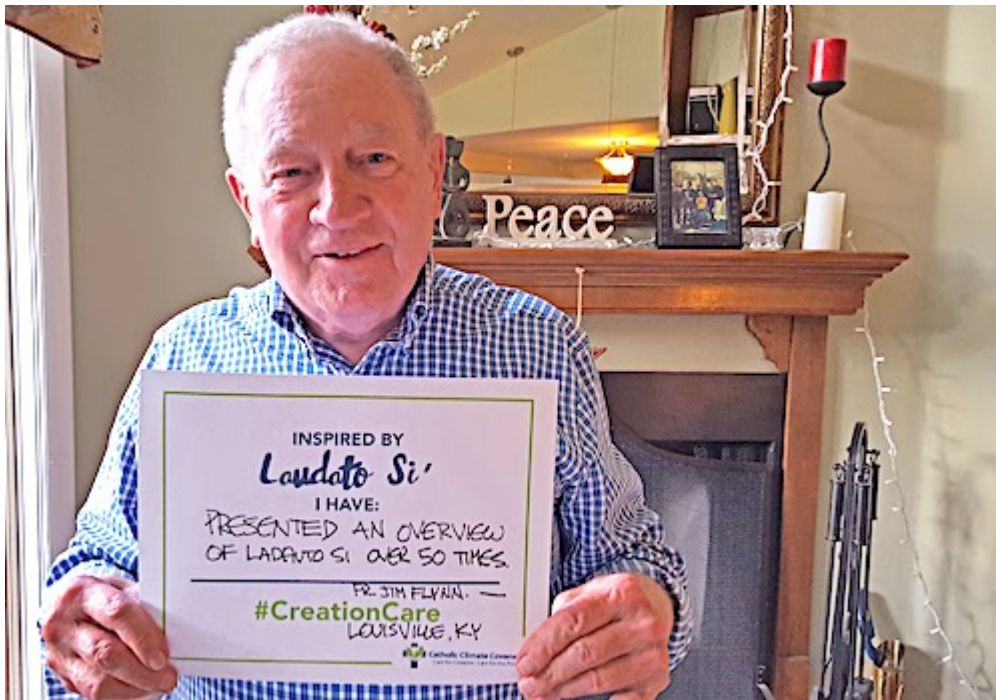


When I discovered in June 2015 that Pope Francis' encyclical, On Care for Our Common Home, was available online, I sat down and read it. It was so astounding to me!
