Supreme Court Justice [John Paul Stevens](#) [1] has hired fewer law clerks than usual, [generating speculation](#) [2] that the leader of the court's liberals will retire next year.

When Justice Sonia Sotomayor joined the court she became only the 12th Catholic in history to reach the Supreme Court. Nevertheless, her appointment brought to six the number of Supreme Court Justices now sitting on the Court.
