The USCCB recently sent out an action alert, reminding us that climate change is at the center of the environmental challenges facing our nation and the world:

"Our response to global climate change raises fundamental questions of morality and justice, fairness and shared sacrifice. People living in poverty - both at home and abroad - contribute least to climate change but they are likely to suffer its worst consequences with few resources to adapt and respond."

The impacts of climate change -- increased temperatures, rising sea levels, and changes in rainfall that contribute to more frequent and severe floods and droughts -- are making the lives of the world's poorest even more precarious
