Reflect on the following:

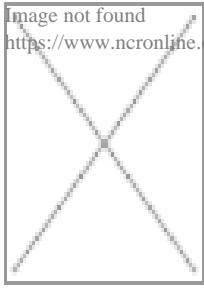
How much of what you do each day is service and what part is just work?
