

Pelosi At Nobel Peace Prize Ceremony

House Speaker [Nancy Pelosi flew to Oslo](#) [1] to be present at the Nobel Prize Ceremony today where an empty chair sat on the stage where the Nobel laureate, Liu Xiaobo, was prevented from attending by the Chinese regime.

Pelosi's presence should be praised by left and right alike: The Communist Chinese regime is a threat, a large threat, to what all Americans value most: our civil liberties.
