

Gehring Calls on Bishops to Refute Cong. Ryan

John Gehring has [a post up at Faith in Public Life](#) [1] that reminds the bishops of their own history in creating the New Deal and urges the bishops to take on Cong. Ryan, a professor at Catholic University and staffer at what was then known as the National Catholic Welfare Conference, the forerunner of today's USCCB.
