

DOJ Joins Fight for Prisoners' Rights

So, it was especially heartening to learn that the [Department of Justice has filed suit](#) [1] against Berkeley County, South Carolina, which has a "Bibles-only" policy for inmates' access to reading materials. The case involves religious freedom, insofar as non-Christian prisoners should be able to access the holy books of their traditions. The Justice Department brief specifically cited the First Amendment's religious guarantees.
