The Provincial Council of the St. Albert the Great (Central) Province, Lay Dominicans has issued the following statement in support of the Leadership Conference of Women Religious:

The Provincial Leadership of the St. Albert the Great (Central USA) Province of Lay Dominicans stands in solidarity with our Dominican sisters and their sister communities in the LCWR.
