

What near-universal health care has done for Massachusetts

U.S. Catholic reports [1] an analysis by *The Atlantic* that says Massachusetts is experiencing a significant reduction in abortions.

While correlation with near-universal health care in Massachusetts is not the same as cause-and-effect, the data do suggest access to health care reduces abortions.

U.S. Catholic questions whether Catholics should so easily dismiss legislation that might well reduce abortions on a national level.
