The Pew Research Center's in-depth look at Islam is based on 38,000 face-to-face interviews in more than 80 languages covering 39 countries. Anyone who covers religion ought to read this study, not to mention public policy makers.

- 2.) Sharia law favored, especially by more devout Muslims
- 3.) Most Muslims believe religion, politics should be intertwined
- 4.) Around the world, Muslims heralded religious freedom
- 5.) Islamic extremism widely rejected, but still a concern
