Joseph Kugler, that was premiered at Sacred Heart Church in Taftville, Connecticut on the one year anniversary of his death, and the other, a prelude on the tune, Darwall, for my 34th birthday Mass, which was also a fundraiser for the organ fund at St. Matthew's Cathedral. Bennett's work on the current recording is very beautiful, as are these other works from female composers. Beauty helps create a culture of life, so listen!
