But they didn't pick up the phone, leading the pontiff to wonder out loud what the women were up to.

According to an ABC news [report](#) [1], he left them a voicemail in Spanish, which said:

What are the nuns doing that they can't answer [the phone]? I am Pope Francis, I wish to greet you in this end of the year, I will see if I can call you later. May God bless you!
