- Bridgeport, R.I. -- Bishop Frank Caggiano [has agreed to meet with representatives of national and local victim support groups](#) [1] who Wednesday called for him to hire an outside firm to investigate two priests who have been accused in the past of sex abuse.
- Springfield, Mass. -- Massachusetts catholic bishops call for minimum wage hike ['an important step toward fairness and justice.'](#) [2]

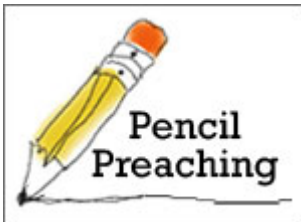
Portland, Maine -- [Churches to hold mill workers' benefit in Cape Elizabeth](#) [6]. 200 workers laid off since December.
